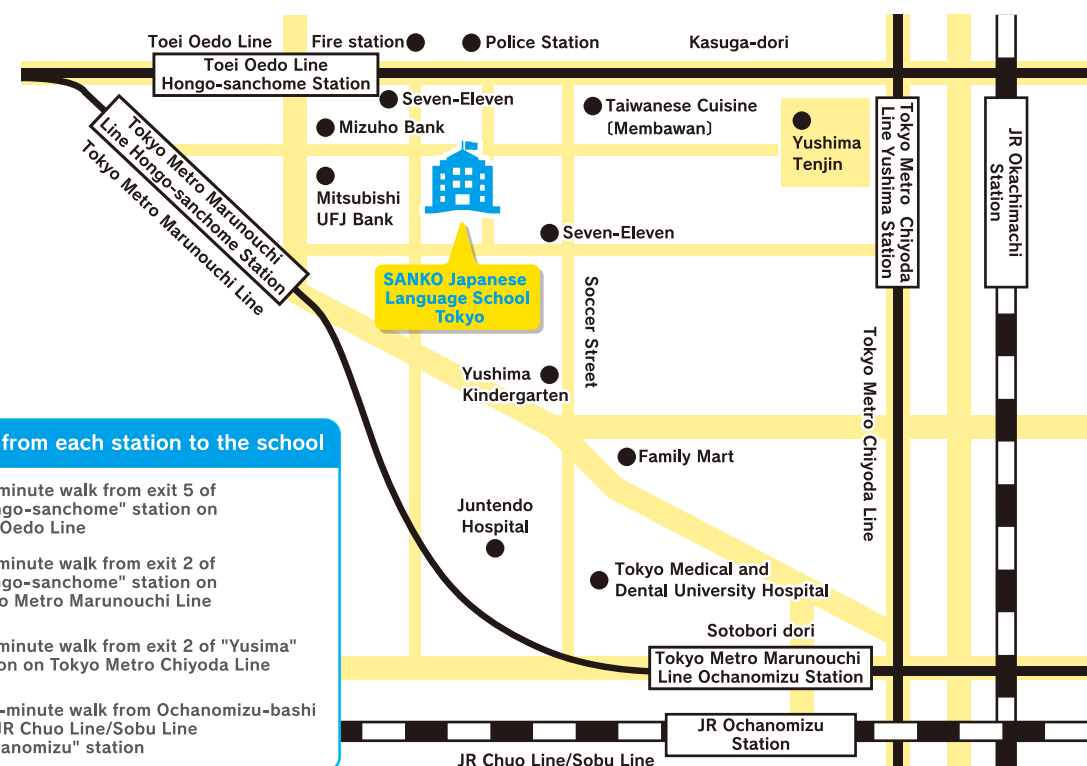
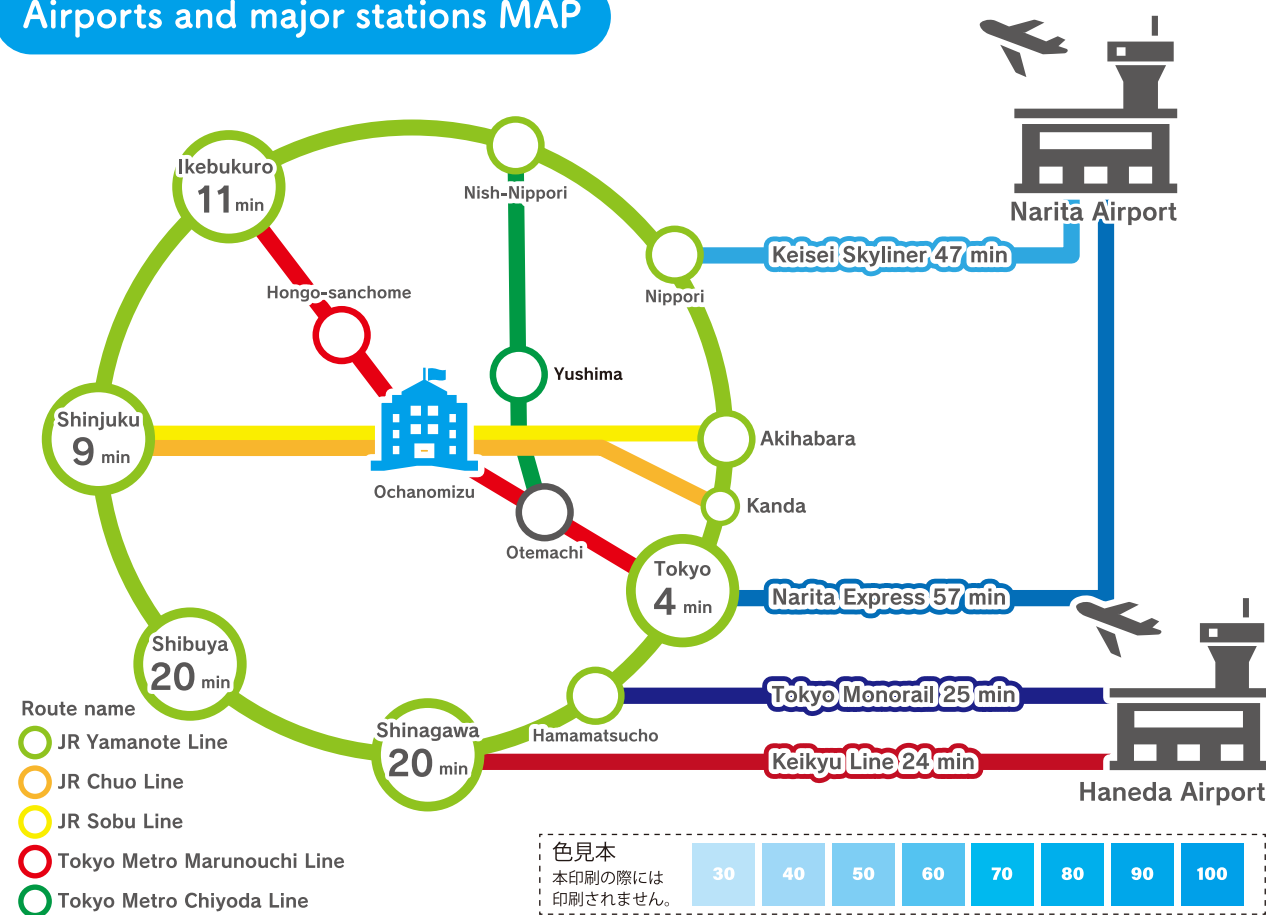


Access Map

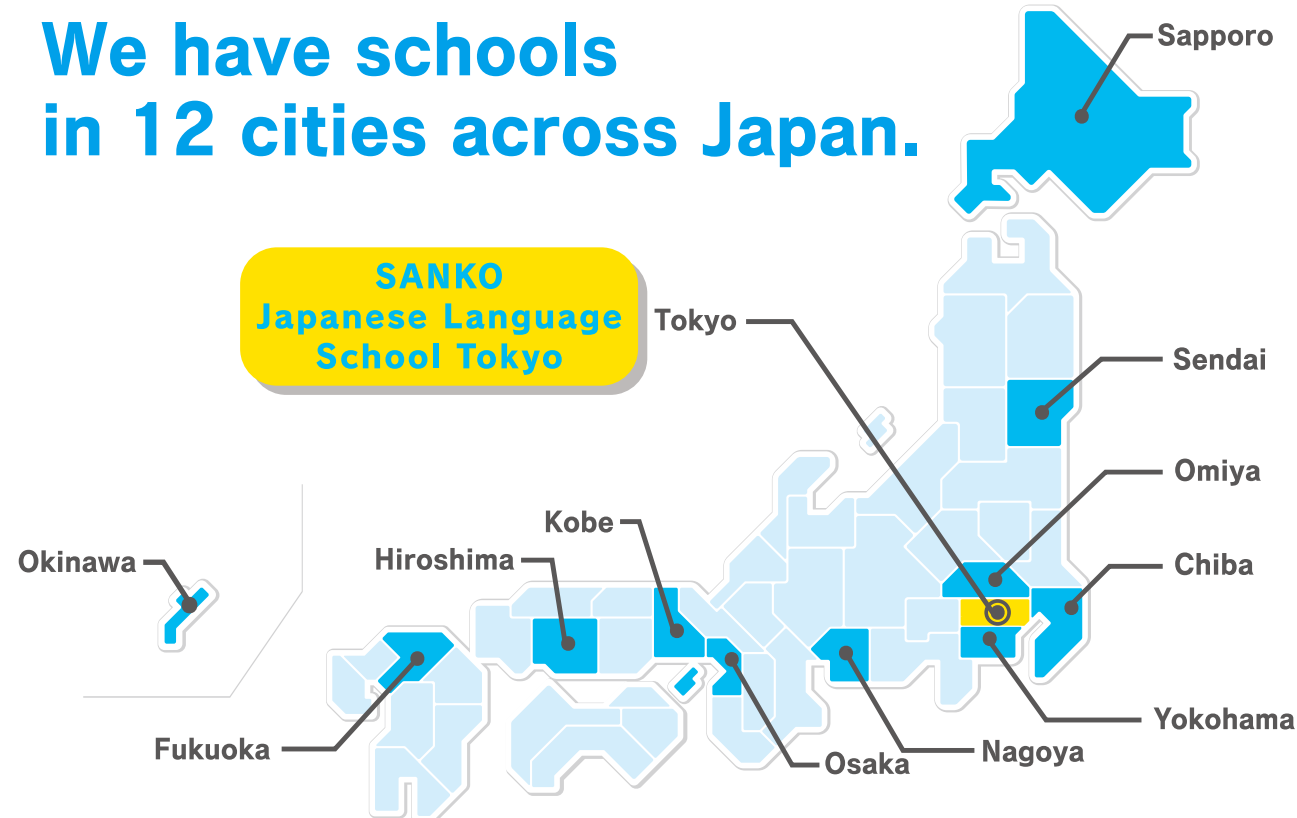


SANKO Japanese Language School Tokyo is operated by Educational Corporation Sanko Gakuen, one of the largest group in size in Japan.

Students who have acquired a certain level of Japanese language proficiency are exempted from paying up to 70,000 yen in tuition!

*The amount of the grant is exempted from the first year's tuition.
